Under expenses, the \$79.71 was for club members' shirt embroideries; the \$35 is finally for an NCCC membership dues check that cleared the bank for a member who joined the club in December/first part of January; the \$15 was for Gale's TSA badge renewal. At the end of March, we had \$7,401.52 in the bank.

A motion was made by Holly to accept the Treasurer's Report and was seconded by Brenda. All were in favor.

Governor's Report– Gale Haugen

Gale informed everyone of the April 30th autocross being hosted by Vapor Trail Vettes; the Gamblers Classic is being hosted by Corvettes of Bakersfield in Laughlin, Nevada on May 12-14; the 2022 NCCC National Convention will be held in Atlantic City, New Jersey from June 12-17, 2022; the 2023 NCCC National Convention will be held in Bowling Green, Kentucky; and the 2024 NCCC National Convention will be held in Joplin, Missouri.

Corvette Blast 2022 Update **By Gale Haugen**

On April 14th Gale met with Tony Bluem, Director of Sales & Marketing, at the Santa Maria Inn to discuss reserving rooms, parking for the car show, and dinner options for the VTV annual Corvette Blast which is scheduled for October 14th and 15th.

Unfortunately, the cost of rooms at the Pismo Beach Shore Cliff hotel prevented the club from hosting our Blast there again. Room rates were \$399.61 plus tax at the Shore Cliff versus \$124 plus tax at the Santa Maria Inn.

Parking at the Santa Maria Inn, with the exception of the handicap parking, will be in the same parking section in front of the hotel bar area as the last event we hosted there.

Due to the increased cost of plated dinners and buffet we will need to charge more in registration fees this year. All plated dinners are running from \$37 to \$47. Buffet style dinners are \$42 per person.

This will be a challenging year to host this event given the shortage of members that have taken on a lot of responsibility in the past. I trust by all of working together we can have a successful event.

Tech Corner – 2023 C8 Production To Start May 16th!

Due to the Corvette plant shutdown last month, it looks like Chevy is going to have to keep making the 2022 C8's for a week longer than previously planned.

The 2023 C8 is now scheduled to start production on Monday, May 16th. This production start will not include the Z06, as the ability for the dealers to even put in an order is not scheduled until late spring. There is no word on when the Z06 will enter production.

According to Keith over at Corvette Blogger, there will be constraints on some of the options when the 2023 production starts: The manual limited-slip differential is constrained but the electronic limited-slip differential is available. The result is that those wanting Z51 with Mag-Ride will get their cars faster.

Another constraint is the ZZ3 Engine Appearance and Lighting Package, which has also been on the constraint list since January after the original vendor closed its carbon fiber business.

On the plus side, the 70th Anniversary Packages will be readily available as will the dealer-installed LPO 5ZZ High Wing Spoiler.

The Rear Park Assist hasn't been available since the end of January but will start reappearing on the 2022 Stingrays being built beginning the week of April 11th. For those that had their cars built without rear park assist, you will most likely hear from Chevrolet sometime in the 4th quarter about a free retrofit of the park assist module.

Corvette Trivia

In 1951 a group of Harley Earl's "Special Projects" crew began work on a GM sports car. Bob McLean designed a general layout for the car.. The project was code named, "Opel".

William Durant, the founder of GM, said a wallpaper pattern he saw in a Paris hotel in 1908 inspired the bow tie logo. Supposedly, he ripped off a small piece of it and brought it back to Detroit.

The man who named the Corvette was Myron Scott... Then Chevrolet's Chief photographer.

The Jaguar XK120 is believed to have been the inspiration for the first Corvette.

The Corvette was the first and last car with a "Wrap-Around" windshield.

Corvette was not the first to be made with a fiberglass body, but it was the first to be built by a company the size of Chevrolet.

Corvettes have been assembled in three different cities. Flint, St. Louis, and Bowling Green.

"Turbojet" as first used on Corvette engine air cleaners with a horsepower rating of greater than 390hp.

The original front emblem and horn button on the "Autorama" Corvette featured crossed American and Checkered flags. It was discovered that using an American flag on a product trade mark was against the law and the emblem was changed before the New York Motorama.

The first Corvettes were actually "rolled" off the assembly line. Chevrolet was not prepared for grounding to a fiberglass body; the cars would not start.

One of the few ways to differentiate between a 1956 and 1957 Corvette without opening the hood is to look at the inside rear view mirror. On the 1956 model, it adjusts with a thumbscrew, on the 1957 adjustment requires a wrench to loosen the locknut.

The 1961 Corvette was the last year to feature "Wide Whitewall" tires.

1962 Was the last of the solid rear axle Corvettes and the last year for the power top on the roadster.

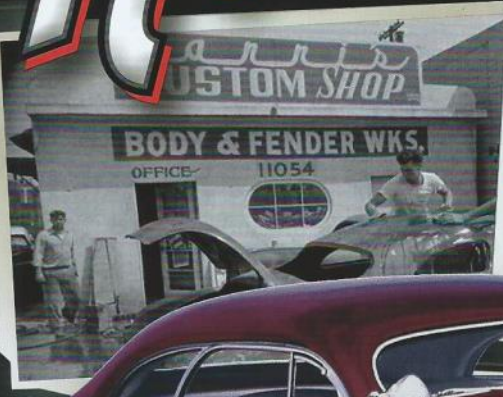

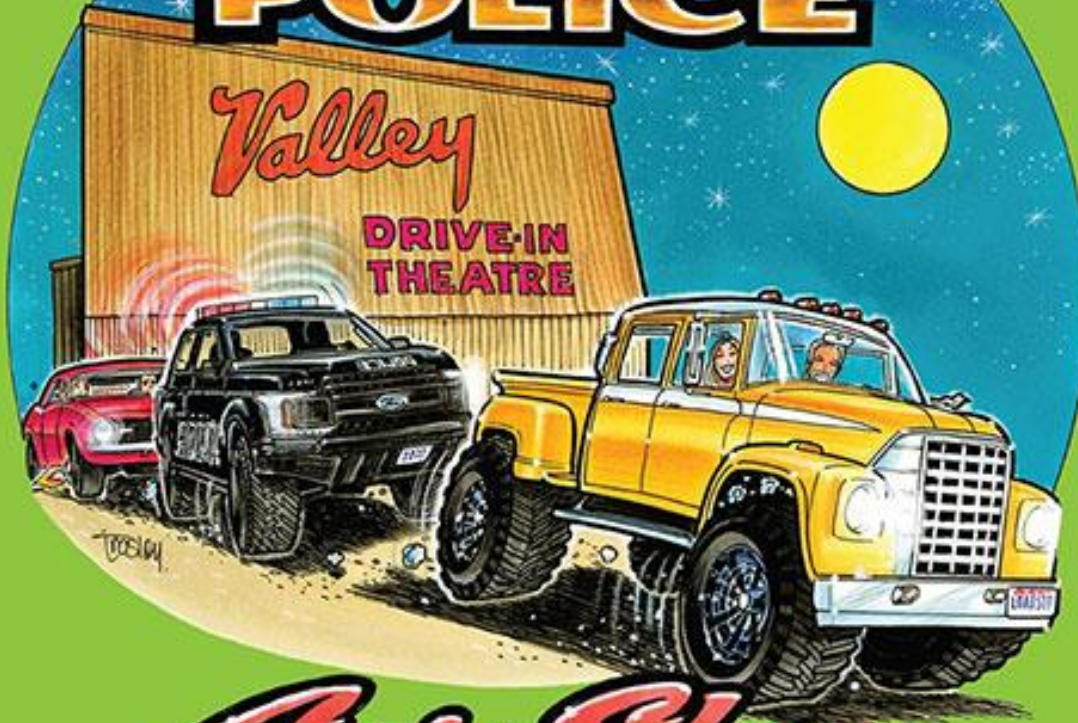
