### Old/New Business Gale for Clay Beck

The first item under old/new business was the July 29<sup>th</sup> autocross Results and Lessons Learned.

Chuck started out by going over the income and expenses for the July 29<sup>th</sup> autocross. The total income was \$3,802.60 and this came from registrations.

### Treasurer's Report- Chuck Robertson

. The total expenses were \$2,803.88. The expenses were \$297.63 for the portable johns, \$6.45 for ice, \$550 to the Santa Maria Airport for the use of the track, \$500 to the Allan Hancock Scholarship Foundation. The \$1,334.80 was primarily for the last installment toward the sealing of the track, and \$115 for NCCC fees.

Next, Chuck went over the treasury reports for July. July started out with \$11,8163.15 in the bank. Under June Income, we had \$500 from Home Motors for their sponsorship, \$420 for the Blast registrations. The \$3,782.60 were for the June 24<sup>th</sup> autocross, and \$30 for the 50/50. The year-to-date income through July was \$16,548.75. The expenses were \$2,391.25 of which \$500 went to the Allan Hancock College Scholarship Foundation and \$1,891.25 for the June 24<sup>th</sup> autocross.

Gale asked for approval of the Treasurer's Report. Larry made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report, and Brian seconded it. All were in favor and the motion was approved.

### **VP** Report—

Gale went over the VP report in an acting capacity. She went over the following potential activities:

- The Pismo Beach Clam Festival Parade. We had an invitation from the organizers but after some discussion no one seemed interested.
- The All-Corvette Car Show sponsored by Corvette Super Sport on August 19<sup>th</sup>. There was no discussion.
- Brian brought up the Mullin Museum in Oxnard. There was some discussion, and it was approved by many of the members. A tentative date was scheduled for October 28<sup>th</sup>. The entry fee is \$14, and everyone needs to get their tickets online.
- Solvang Ostrich land USA. Some members have been to it.
- The Lavender Farm.
- Powder Coating business. Gerry is still working on it. Larry brought up another powder coating shop.

# Tech Corner -Corvette Production Schedule

Production of the 2024 Corvette Stingray and 2024 Corvette Z06 is set to begin September 11<sup>th</sup>.

Meanwhile, production of the 2024 <u>Corvette E-</u> <u>Ray</u> is currently scheduled to begin October 23<sup>rd</sup>.

### Tech Corner -Corvette Production Schedule

The official 2024 Corvette <u>online configurator</u> <u>tool</u> is now available at <u>Chevrolet</u>'s website.

Orders for the 2024 Corvette Stingray and 2024 Corvette Z06 began July 27<sup>th</sup>, while orders for the 2024 Corvette E-Ray will open August 17<sup>th</sup>.

All Corvette C8 variants are produced exclusively at the <u>GM Bowling Green plant</u> in Kentucky.

As GM Authority covered previously, the 2024 Corvette destination freight charge (DFC) is <u>more expensive</u> than that of the preceding 2023 model year, increasing \$200 to \$1,595.

With regard to the technical specs, the 2024 Corvette Stingray features the naturally aspirated <u>6.2L V8 LT2</u> gasoline engine, which produces 490 horsepower and 465 pound-feet of torque. The 2024 Corvette Z06 cradles the naturally aspirated <u>5.5L V8 LT6</u> gasoline engine, rated at 670 horsepower and 470 pound-feet of torque. Finally, the new-for-2024 Corvette E-Ray cradles both the 6.2L V8 LT2 gasoline engine and a front-mounted electric motor, the combination of which produced 655 horsepower. The GM Y2 platform provides the underpinnings across the Corvette C8 lineup.

### Mullin Automotive Museum Trip By Gale

The Mullin Auto Museum was founded in 2010 and hosts the worlds largest private collection of Bu-gatti's.

The building is nearly 47,000 square feet of exhibit space with a roof garden, theater, gift shop, archival storage, a collection of unrestored vehicles and Bugatti furniture hand crafted by the patriarch of the Bugatti Family, Carlo Bugatti.

Don't leave the museum without seeing the "Lady of the Lake" which is a 1925 Bugatti that spent 75 years in Lake Maggiore which is 80% in Italy and 20% in Switzerland. If you enjoy reading history go to <u>https://mattstonecars.com/the-lady-in-thelake/.</u>
