Gale gave a status on this year's Blast which is scheduled for October 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup>. She and Chuck are trying to iron out the prices for food and facilities.

## NCCC Regional Governors Meeting By Gale Haugen

A regional governors meeting was held on May 11, 2024. This was the first Zoom meeting held by the West Coast and Northwestern Regions. There was a little learning curve and a 45 minute time constraint but Joe Orrico was able to manage both very well.

Dues owed the region for sanctioned and non-sanctioned events sponsored by a club was discussed. A club is responsible for payment to the region for all non-NCCC members at \$2 per person. There are no dues for a NCCC member. A car show is \$2 per car. This has not changed from previous years but was reiterated for the new WC governors.

From the National NCCC Meeting in February two clarifications were discussed. The first one involved funkhanas and not allowing convertibles to participate with the top down if there are coups in the class. This was left for the event chairperson to decide. The second involved allowing minors in the new style funkhana beginning at age 9. This is similar to the rule allowing minors to be navigators in rallies. It passed unanimously.

Offices for up for re-election in November are President, Vice President of Membership, Treasurer and Director of Public Relations. If you are interested or know someone who would be a good candidate please let me know.

The following Rule Changes were tabled until the May National NCCC Meeting which was held May 3-4, 2024.

- Rule Changes R1-R4 were tabled for the May meeting for further discussions with membership.
- Rule Changes R7-R9 were tabled for the May meeting to come back as Clarifications (R7 andR8) and Revision of Rule Change (R9).
- Clarification 2024-1 was tabled for the May meeting. • Clarification 2024-2 was approved by a 8-6 vote.
